3. Grading of Teams.

Clubs had been issued with the proposed grading of teams based on the Nominations that had been received.

Grade 18/Grade 16: Logic of combing these teams/age groups explained. Will allow G18 teams to play within ESFA and provide quality G16 teams with added competition, without impacting their ability to represent at Champion of Champions. Will assist in further assessment of these age groups.

The highest placed G16 & G18 will be considered ESFA League Champions and would be nominated as ESFA representative in Champion of Champions.

Separate final series will be played in each age group. 2v3 with the winner to play 1 in the Grand Final.

All players in G16 teams must meet G16 age guidelinesguidelines.

Amendment to the time played in the competition, will now be 40mins each way, with is 5 mins less for G18 and 5 min more for G16.

Grade 16: 8 teams have been placed into this competition and will play as one division. There will be a Championship and Pennant Final series therefore all teams will play 'finals' football.

Grade 15: 8 teams have been placed into this competition and will play as one division. There will be a Championship and Pennant Final series therefore all teams will play 'finals' football.

Grade 14: There will be two divisions in the age group; Division 1 – 4 teams which will include a G13 team from East FC. Division 2 will consist of 5 teams at this stage, however there is a possibility of another team being added.

Grade 13: It was originally proposed that there would be two (2) divisions, however there was a withdrawal at the meeting of a team which meant that running two divisions would not be feasible. Therefore there will be 1 division of 7 teams, ~~with results being monitored.~~

Grade 12: There was an error in the documentation issued as 1 team had been left off. With a total of 9 teams, it was agreed by clubs that 1 full round be completed ~~at which time and a~~ a review of the results be done and decision made as to the future conduct of the competition. regarding 're-grading' to further divisions

NB : Any regrading of the above competitions/division, will be undertaken as per the Competition Rules and the regrading protocols, which occur at the completion of the first round of the highest division.

26 March 2012 – draw for 1st week issued.

3. General Business (from the floor):

Pagewood FC: Issued raised in relation to players playing in a high age group/division and how this would be monitored.

Advised that this should be monitored by the ESFA office and clubs notified should they have a player approaching the maximum number of times which they have played in a high age group/division.

Also request with regards to clarification on this rule in regards to the Final Series. This will be investigated further.
